These dimensions and formats look best!

File Format

PNG is recommended,
but we do accept JPG

Size Limit

Max 10 MB

Resolution

At least 1000 pixels on the shorter side, or min.
4000 pixels on the longer side.
Recommended: 4000 by 4000 pixels

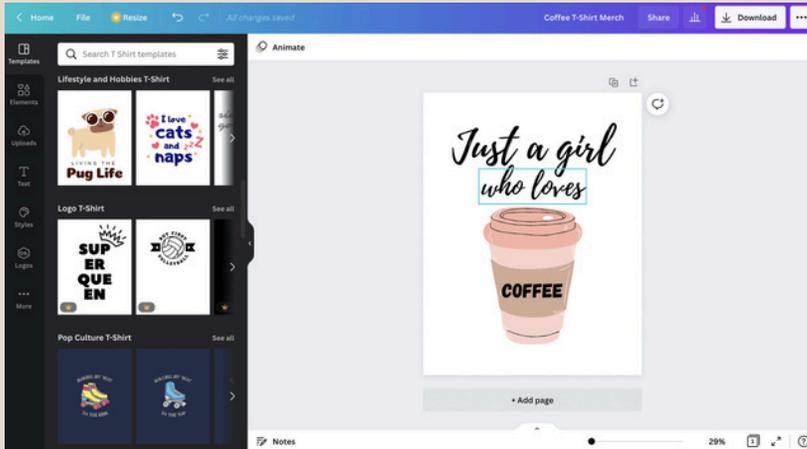
Background

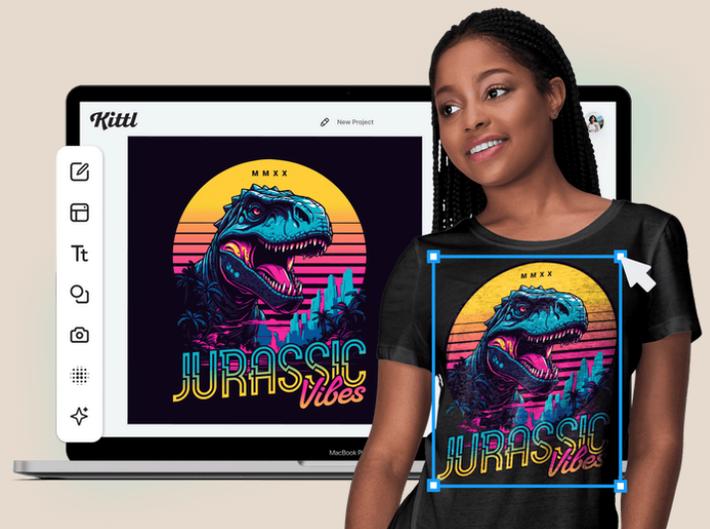

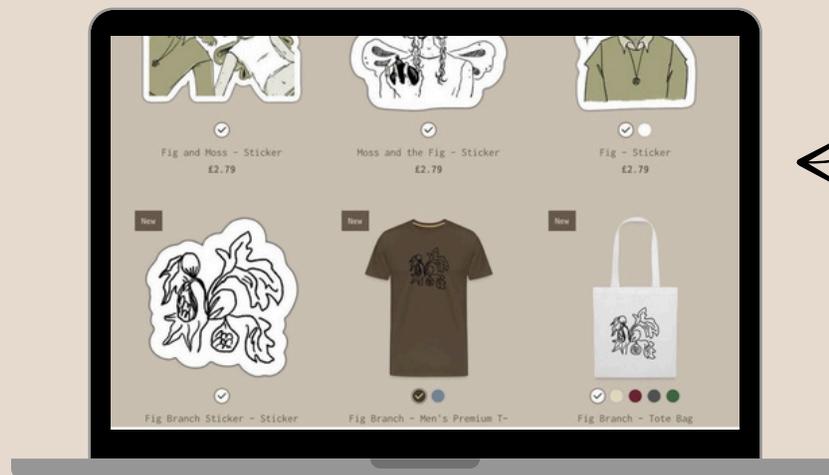

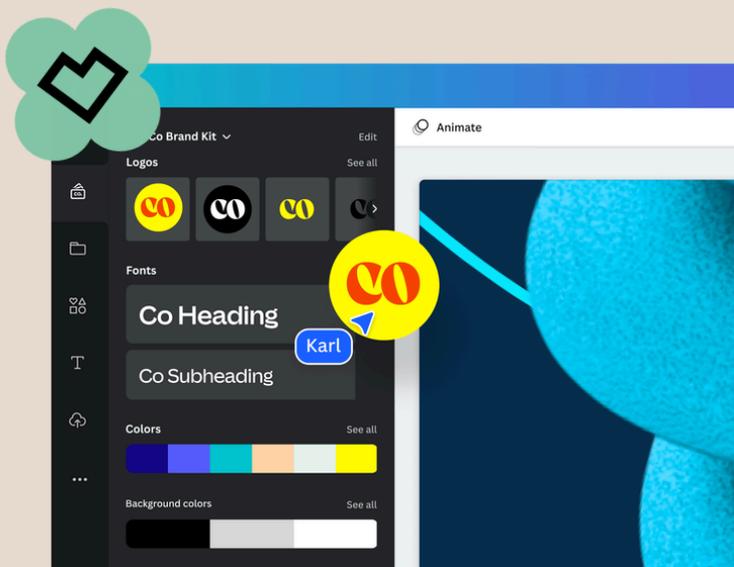




Design Hacks

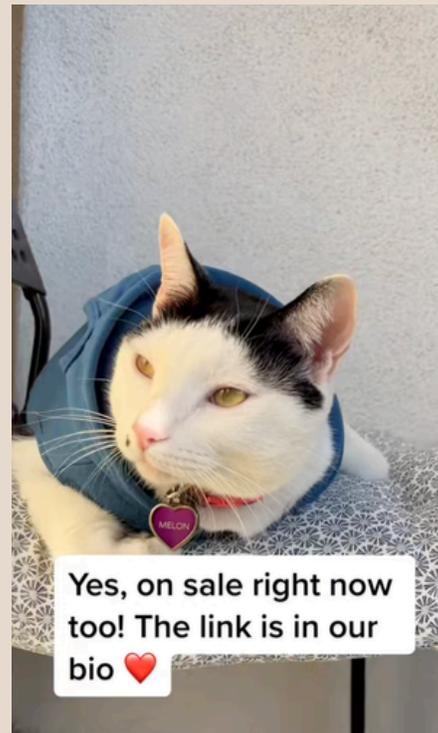
